Greg Bailey (Bailey, Hodshire & Company, P.C.) presented compilation of financial statement. Presentation details are in the financial statement.

Officers Reports:

• Secretary - Leela Han

Presented May. 14, 2020, minutes. On a motion by Linda Walker and seconded by Jeff Bennett, the minutes were approved.

• President - Jodi Dahlberg

- Weir in Inlet 2: Contacted Wilcox Landscaping to get a quote to remove the trees. We may have to take weir apart to remove overgrown trees and

then put the weir back together. This requires DEQ approval. Further news on this will be updated at the next meeting.

- Weir in Inlet 1: Filed with DEQ, now in the 30-day holding period for decisions and questions. Will be updated.
- Dam Repair: Hillsdale County was contacted as one side of the dam is
 deteriorating faster than expected. The County is preparing a proposal for
 fixing the dam. The county is responsible for maintaining the structure and
 inspection, but the association is responsible for maintaining the dam.
 LSPOA will be charged for the inspection and repairing of the dam. The
 cost will be added to the taxes. The amount will be updated.
- Theft around the lake: There have been thefts around the lake. Residents are being reminded to lock doors, cars, and sheds.
- Dredging Update: Presented a statement

-----Beginning of Statement-----

Dredging of paths 3 through 7 has the possibility of delay due to an issue with return water from holding cell number 2. Wes Rhodes (10492 Somerset Road) had agreed to let us lay the pipe on his land in 2019. He had relayed this to Jodi Dahlberg as the project lead and to Jim Weber as the President at that time. Jim had told him compensation for any damage to his grass and/or landscaping would be granted. We have the plan for the holding cell, the permits and equipment coming next week to build that cell. Everything was set and on track to start dredging with the second dredge in a few weeks.

On Monday, 6/8/2020, after Wes was informed of the details and plans, he informed me via phone, the president of the Association, that he now requires the members of this community to pay him and his neighbor Tom Russell (10496 Somerset Road) \$17,000 to use that area for 85 days. If it runs over 85 days, he has requested the members of this community to pay him an additional \$200 a day. Wes has made \$9500 from LSPOA on this project and \$850 from Savin as of 6/11/2020.

The dredging budget is already over the original cost due to issues with the holding cells and land clearing and the first dredge company's financial scam. We cannot afford to pay a member of this community \$17,000 to lay pipe over his grass. Until we have a solution, the dredging has the

possibility of suspension after dredge path 2 as holding cell number 1 will be filled.
